Research reveals, that when a workplace culture is infected by a workplace bully, the workplace divides into two 'camps'...those who side with the 'bully', and those who don't.

Siding with the bully can be anything from participating in bullying behaviours (mobbing); to turning a 'blind eye' to workplace bullying behaviour; to withdrawing support from 'bullied' colleagues for fear of becoming the next target of the bully.

When it comes to workplace bullying, we ask that people make a firm choice on where they stand...either in support of workplace bullying, or not. To quote Eldridge Cleaver: *You're either part of the solution or you're part of the problem.*
